

## Standards Analysis Report

The Standards Analysis report shows student performance by standard for institutions, teachers, students, or subgroups. The Standards Analysis report supports current-year and past-year data, depending on which was selected on the Reporting Dashboard.

**Note:** Teachers can view other teachers' information on the Standards Analysis report only if they have the *View teacher comparison data* operation (this depends on district policy). To see another teacher's sections, you must also have the *Manage instruction* operation.

### To view the Standards Analysis report

1. Go to **Reporting > Reporting Dashboard**.
2. Select a district, region, school, or teacher/section.
3. Optional: In the **Results reflect** dropdown, select the enrollment.
4. For the appropriate test, click the report button and select **Standards Analysis**, or click the test row and then click the **Standards Analysis** tab on the Test Report page.
5. Optional: In the **Order columns by** dropdown, select whether to order the columns by standard or performance (high or low).
6. Change the selected **Standard Document** and **Standard Level** as needed.
7. Select the **Primary Alignments Only** check box to include only primary standards in the report, or clear the check box to include all aligned standards.
8. Next to **Performance Comparison By**, click one of the following tabs:
  - **District/Region/School/Teacher/Student:** You can change the scope by clicking an institution or section icon in the table to drill down. The views available depend on your permissions.
  - **Subgroup:** Click to view a comparison of student groups for the currently selected institution or teacher.
9. Optional: Click **Export to Excel** to create a spreadsheet of the report.

### About the Standards Analysis report

The Standards Analysis report includes the following information:

- **Standard Performance chart:** Shows a bar for each standard with the average score. Hover over a bar to see the standard description and see the average score and number of aligned items.
- **Performance Comparison by District/Region/School/Teacher/Student/Subgroup:** The table shows the number of students who took the test, the Average Score (Overall), and the Average Score for each standard. In parentheses, the total points achieved and total points possible are shown, for example (91/100). Click a number in the # Students column to view the student set for a row (the link is available only when the student set contains 2000 or fewer students). At the teacher level, click the section icon under a teacher name to view results for students in the section. You must be the teacher or have the appropriate permissions to view this information.

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
